Summary: This demonstration model teaches the principles of how tornadoes form. Students will learn about how a strong updraft is important, about convergence and rotation, funnel speed and how it is related to funnel width, and many more exciting tornado facts. Grades: 5-9



MOD 634.9 TRE SCI

Tree study field kit: the all-in-one tree study field kit for students and teachers

Contents: 10 increment core holders (white plastic) -- 1 8" two-thread increment borer -- 1 tangent height gauge -- 1 10' diameter tape (small orange) -- 1 tree identification book -- 1 log scale stick -- 1 100' fiberglass measuring tape -- 1 roll environmental blue flagging -- 1 roll environmental orange flagging -- 1 20' diameter tape -- 1 set of lesson plans --

Summary: Gain a new appreciation for forests and trees! Kit includes a Tree Finder illustrated manual to determine species, a tangent height gauge and 50m measuring tape to figure heights, and a diameter tape. Study annual growth rings by extracting a core sample with a professional model 8" increment borer (with 10 core holder cards). Students can also determine the volume of wood in a tree by using the tree scale stick. Also includes biodegradable roll flagging and stake wire flags to delineate research areas. Six plastic handheld magnifiers, six packs of six tree cookies, 12" ruler, lesson plans correlated with National Science Education Standards, and carrying case box are also included. Grades: 4-12.

Sail car class pack

Summary: Understanding wind energy is a breeze when students build and launch sail cars powered only by the wind from a fan. Students observe the friction force that impedes their cars' forward motion and learn to adjust the position of the sail to take advantage of wind currents. This activity can be used to supplement elementary alternative energy or natural science curricula. The class pack provides enough materials for 50 sail cars and includes instructions. Fan is included. Grades: 3-6

Foam fraction burger class set

Contents: 15 hamburgers (9 layers each) -- 1 activity guide

Summary: Foam fraction burgers can be used to teach parts or fractions to a whole in the round. Grades: 2-6.

Summary: Model 1. Ventral dissection of the bullfrog. Half the lower jaw is removed, and the digestive system is spread to reveal deeply lying organs. The circulatory and reproductive (female) systems are shown in detail. Model 2. Natural bone. Fully articulated bullfrog skeleton in extended position and mounted in a double-view display case. Grades: 6-12.
