Birth to Three Program Special Education Teacher – Part-Time

Deadline for Application: December 20, 2023

Cooperative Educational Service Agency 10 (CESA 10) is looking for an individual to serve as a part-time (190 days/20 hours/week) with the possibility of full-time, Birth to Three Program Special Education Teacher. The Birth to Three Program Special Education Teacher is responsible for providing early intervention services to children (ages birth to three) in the environment in which the child naturally spends his/her day. The teacher completes evaluations, provides direct instruction, and addresses all areas of development by coaching the families/caregivers based on the outcomes developed in the IFSP. The teacher works closely with team members to help support the families through the entire birth to three process.

Candidates are required to have a bachelor's degree and Wisconsin DPI Certification #1809. Two years of successful experience is preferred but not required.

Performance Responsibilities:

- A. Completes screenings, evaluations of children with suspected delays in development, including reporting of findings
- B. Participates in the development, review, and evaluation of the Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP)
- C. Maintains continued regular contact with families, as mandated, to ensure that services are being delivered appropriately and in a timely manner
- D. Accurately and comprehensively document case notes and reports
- E. Completes ongoing assessment of the developmental progress and function of children served
- F. Support parents with coordinating medical and other health care providers as needed
- G. Assist service coordinators with the development of transitional/discharge plans
- H. Understands and upholds the components of the Primary Coach Approach to Teaming (PCATT) model for early intervention
- I. Assists parents in locating community resources
- J. Supports team members as needed in providing services to families/caregivers and during teaming meetings
- K. Attends meetings as appropriate, including in-house and community meetings relating to Birth to Three
