Cooperative Educational Services Agency 10 (CESA 10) is looking for an individual to serve as full-time, school year, Business and Industry Partnership Consultant to be based in Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin. This position supports school districts that have contracted for College and Career Readiness services. The Consultant works directly with regional business and industry employers and workforce development groups. Individual will be responsible for assisting the Director of College and Career Readiness to establish sustainable relationships between area employers and K-12 school district administrators, school counselors, Career and Technical Education teachers, and other K-12 teachers throughout CESA 10.

Qualifications: The ideal candidate will possess a bachelor's degree, but a master's degree in education would be preferred, with a minimum of five years of experience in education and/or business and industry. Experience delivering professional development training is preferred.

Related Skills:

- Evidence of excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Evidence of the ability to work collaboratively with a variety of stakeholders.
- Evidence of strong problem-solving skills and ability to be solution oriented.
- Evidence of strong organizational skills and ability to meet deadlines.
- Evidence of willingness to be a flexible and self-directed learner.
- Willingness to learn regional labor market information and future trends; Career and Technical Education (CTE); aspects of Academic and Career Planning (ACP); and aspects of Wisconsin Regional Career Pathways.
- Willingness to learn the importance of career-based learning experiences to attract and retain local talent, including Youth Apprenticeship (YA).
- Willingness to learn what academic, technical and employability skills are needed in the current and future workforce.

Performance Responsibilities:

- Promote work-based learning experiences for students.
- Use labor market information to identify employment trends for careers in high demand in our region.
- Create a plan of action to connect area employers to districts that contract for services.
- Assist with planning impactful educator events with the goal of informing K-12 teachers, school counselors and administrators about local workforce needs and skills necessary in the changing job market.
- Assist with planning impactful student and parent engagement events to attract and retain local talent. Examples include organizing local or regional evening tours of business and industry facilities, parent lunch events at area businesses, or business and industry panel discussions.
- Assist with planning and delivery of professional learning opportunities to include business and industry partners.
